Overview	<p>Materials Students will independently collect appropriate materials from the school site.</p> <p>Students will be taught how to lift correctly and carry materials safely to avoid injury.</p> <p>Students will understand the multiple uses of wood.</p> <p>Students will independently organise the materials depending on their purpose.</p>	<p>Team Building Students will access a variety of team building games.</p> <p>All students will have the opportunity to become a team leader within a game.</p> <p>Although games will be adult-led, students will be encouraged to develop their leadership skills within the games.</p>	<p>Fire making Students will be taught the health and safety rule when using fire in the Forest School grounds.</p> <p>Under adult supervision, students will independently light the fires within the Forest School grounds.</p> <p>With adult support, students will work with fire, exploring different types of fire and the impact it can have.</p>	<p>Bushcraft Students will explore the term “waterproof”.</p> <p>Students will revisit the term “den” and will verbally recap how a simple den can be made.</p> <p>With support, students will create waterproof dens, appropriate for people to live in.</p>	<p>Tools Students will recap on tools they have previously used in previous years/ outside of school time.</p> <p>Students will independently demonstrate a safe way of using tools.</p> <p>Students will model to their peers how to safely use tools.</p>	<p>Cooking Students will independently make a range of foods and drinks.</p> <p>Students will develop fine motor skills such as chopping and cutting.</p> <p>Students will develop resilience by working through all weathers.</p>
