How do we know what the weather will be like today? Make a weather station to find out more about the weather in your area. What weather do you prefer? Sunshine, snow, storms, or showers? Get your wellies on and let's go.	Let's find out all about London, including its history, transport, and famous landmarks. Step back in time and discover what happened in the Great Fire of London. Create a model of the bakery on Pudding Lane, then burn it to the ground to recreate the Great Fire. Are you ready for the bright lights of the big city? Hop in a black cab and enjoy the ride.	This project teaches pupils about historically significant people who have had a major impact on the world. They will learn to use timelines, stories and historical sources to find out about the people featured and use historical models to explore their significance.	Oh, I do like to be beside the seaside. Do you? That's good, because you're about to become an expert beachcomber. Head to your nearest beach to look for interesting and unusual objects, using your senses to spot, sniff and seek them out. We can take a peek into the cool water to learn about the weird and wonderful animals and plants in their microhabitats. Got your shorts and sunglasses on? Bucket and spade at the ready? Let's get beachcombing.	Get your sea legs on, it's time to sail the salty seas. Navigate, investigate and explore the world, just like Captain Cook. Make a boat, sink a ship, fly a pirate flag. Speak like a pirate, write like a poet, then weigh and measure a pirate's booty. How do rescues happen at sea? Find out about brave volunteers and young Miss Darling, rowing her boat across stormy seas.
