KS5	Chosen topic	Medieval society - Life and Religion	The Great Plague	The Victorians	The Civil Rights Movement	The Qing Dynasty
Curriculum	<i>Teacher to choose a topic appropriate to the students in their class.</i>	Students will be learning about life in Medieval times. They will experience a range of aspects from the hierarchy of medieval society to Law and Order in medieval society. Students will discuss how and why Christianity spread and will explore monasteries and covenants. Students will understand the importance of the Church and will know what pilgrimages are.	<p>This half term, students will explore The Great Plague. They will understand where and when the plague began, look for signs and symptoms of the plague, and will look at what happened during the Plague. Students will understand how the Plague spread so quickly and how it could have been prevented.</p> <p>Students will research what happened during the Plague and how we know. Students will know and understand how the Plague ended.</p>	In Spring 2, students will learn about Victorian artefacts. Students will also explore Queen Victoria and will be able to explain how the Industrial Revolution changed society. Students will look into Victorian children/schools and understand how Lord Shaftesbury improved Victorian children's lives. Throughout this half-term, students will research Victorian crime and punishment and look into new inventions and discoveries.	Students will look at a timeline of Civil Rights, The Ku Klux Klan, and Jim Crow Laws. Students will explore school segregation and Brown vs Board of Education. In the latter stages of Summer 1, students will look into Rosa Parks and Martin Luther King and how influential they were in their time. Students will also explore the Civil Rights Movement and will compare the roles of leaders.	Students will explore the time of Chinese Dynasties and the rise of the Qing Dynasty (looking into how a small tribe took over an entire empire?) Students will look into the expansion of Qing Dynasty, Opium Wars and the fall of the Qing Dynasty.

Curriculum	<i>Teacher to choose a topic appropriate to the students in their class.</i>	This half term, students will learn about rivers. They will explore how a river is formed whilst learning about the water cycle. Students will identify the long profile of a river and the different river landforms throughout. Students will research the different river processes, including erosion, transportation and deposition. They will also explore how rivers flood and how this affects communities.	During Spring 1, students will explore climate change. They will learn about the greenhouse effect and what climate change is. Students will research and discover evidence for climate change and the impact this has on the world. Students will explore how sea levels are rising and what humans can do to manage climate change.	Students will explore tropical storms and how they are formed. They will use their learning from the last half term to think about how climate change is affecting tropical storms. Students will explore the primary and secondary effects of climate change and look into real life case studies of tropical storms.	Students will learn about tropical rainforests this half term. They will identify the layers of a rainforest and explore what life is like for people in the rainforest. Students will research deforestation, they will explore the causes and effects of this. They will discuss and share ideas about how humans can help to stop deforestation.	During the last half term, students will be supported to undertake a country case study. Students will choose a country that interests them. They will research this country and look at population, social and economic changes. Students will plan a presentation of their choice and present this to their peers.
