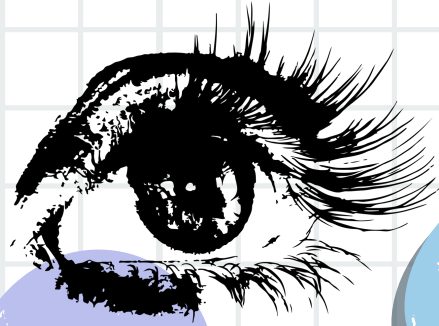

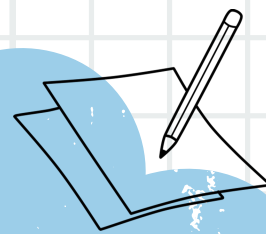
Investigating the human eye structure, light and shadows and how the eye functions.

Biographies

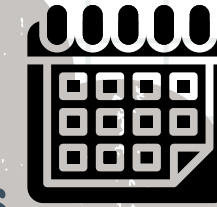
Exploring features and structures of biographies - focusing on diversity by looking into different perspectives.
